### Gastrorcis humblotii 'Orchid Court' AOS/HCC

### Grown by Tennis Maynard

Tennis grows this beautiful orchid cool, in a terrestrial mix (in this case a fine bark/perlite mix with added pro-mix), in cattleya light, kept moist but a little drier in the winter. It also is in the path of the mister which comes on every day for 1/2 hour, sometimes twice a day in the summer.

Our speaker in August was a judging seminar led by Barry Jones. This plant was awarded an HCC which is described on Page 6.


I look forward to seeing all of you at our picnic on September 21.

Award Descríptíon of Tennís's Grastrochís humblotíí 'Orchíd Court'

## The HCC is the Highly Commended Certificate which is given to an orchid which receives 75 to 79 points for its flower quality.

"Six full flat consistent flowers and thirty one buds nicely displayed on three inflorescences up to 65cm; sepals and petals white heavily overlaid magenta; lip white, keel bright canary yellow, side lobes suffused tangerine orange, midlobe deep magenta distally; column green; substance average; texture sepals and petals diamond dust, lip sateny" [sic] ("satiny" is the correct spelling)

The next event that the Mid America Orchid Congress is sponsoring an online zoom presentation by world renowned taxonomist and orchid expert Guido Braem who will present the Genus Tolumnia. Attached is a flyer with more information.

The presentation will be October 20, 2024. Registration is available online and will be paid for by the Central Ohio Orchid Society. If you are a COOS member you will be emailed a link prior to the event. We will be recording the talk so you will be able to re-watch it or see it if you are unable to join live for a couple weeks after the talk.

Mid America Orchid Congress Meeting Report by Bob Dudley

The annual MAOC member's meeting took place on Sunday August 25 during the Ohio Orchid Fest.

The minutes from the August 27, meeting was approved and the Treasurer's Report was then discussed.

As of July 1<sup>st</sup> MOAC has a total balance of \$62,955.25. The total income for 2023 was \$9,359 and total expenses were \$10,816.22 for a loss of \$1,456.72. It was noted that last year's auction earned \$2451 of which 50% went to MAOC. Saturday's Auction earned even more money, the total was not available at the time of the meeting. In addition there was also a silent auction this year.

As of August 1 there were 41 paid members (Orchid Societies) of MOAC. The member societies geographically range from Alabama to Southern Ontario.

There were a number of Committee reports, the most important was the President's Report and the AOS Liaison report. Eric Sauer, President of MOAC stated that the Annual Meeting Committee is looking for a new chair or chairs along with societies to host upcoming MOAC meetings.

The AOS Liaison Committee is chaired by Cheryl Erins who is also the Current President of the AOS. She talked about changes in the AOS (check out the new AOS wedpage if you have not done so). Like all organizations the AOS is trying to bring in younger members. Also discussion have starting about the possibility the next years Ohio Valley Orchid Fest will not only host the annual MOAC meeting but also the AOS annual meeting

Finally a committee was setup to rewrite the Constitution of MOAC. A handout with proposed change of the Constitution was handed out. A report will be made at the next meeting.

Before adjournment it was announced that next years member meeting will be, in all probability, a Zoom meeting.
