You may remember Barry from a zoom meeting in early 2022, where he shared a great presentation about orchid judging, but told us the best way to really learn about judging is to do it in person. Barry will be joining us again in August to speak in person on judging, and to show us how it is done in person. We will have an actual AOS judging at our meeting in August! Bring your very best blooming plants, there is a chance it could win an AOS award! This is a great opportunity to understand how orchids are judge and see it happen in real time.

Barry and his wife Jane have been growing orchids for over 40 years, including many species of Dendrobiums, Bulbophyllums, as well as many other unique orchids. He has been an AOS judge for over 25 years.




