

### **Grown by Ken Mettler**

Ken grows this beautiful Coelogne warm, wet and shady. I now have it potted in coconut husk chunks. It sits in a tray with 1/4-1/2" water at all times. It doesn't like to dry out. Little or no direct sun. Warm temps. 55-85\* is ideal, but can take ten more degrees on either side for short periods of time.

Basically like an African violet, but a little more water.

The next event that the Mid America Orchid Congress is sponsoring an online zoom presentation by world renowned taxonomist and orchid expert Guido Braem who will present the Genus Tolumnia. Attached is a flyer with more information.

The presentation will be October 20, 2024. Registration is available online and will be paid for by the Central Ohio Orchid Society. If you are a COOS member you will be emailed a link prior to the event. We will be recording the talk so you will be able to re-watch it or see it if you are unable to join live for a couple weeks after the talk.

In addition, we will be doing a group order for Guido Braem's books to have them shipped as a bulk order to the US and then shipped to their final address.
